Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of the depository in his hands pay unto John Williams and Richard Hallcome the sum of three dollars and fifty cents each and unto Britain Williams the sum of three dollars per accounts for parting.

September 1796 as then Sheriff of Southampton County to William

against Jane Westbrooke, also for the sum of thirty five pounds
five Shillings and four pence the balance of the principal of
the said Execution and Seven Dollars and eighty eight cents the
costs thereof, which said balance and costs the said Vick is
now liable for, making in the whole the sum of forty two
pounds twelve Shillings and Seven Dollars and eighty eight cents
with interest on the first mentioned sum of five pounds five
Shillings and eight pence from the time it was paid by the
said Vick until paid to him the Vick again, also for interest
on the said sum of thirty five pounds five Shillings four pence
from the day of December 1796 being the return day of the
said Execution, but with this proviso in regard to interest on
the last mentioned sum, that if he the plt should not be
bound to pay the interest on the same he will remit the
same (interest) to the said deft, the full amount of said
Execution of forty two pounds twelve Shillings and Seven
Dollars and eighty eight cents, having been received by the
defendants intestate when acting as Deputy Sheriff under the
said plt, and converted to his own use, and failed to
pay the same to the said W. Westbrooke att^r as aforesaid
or to him the said plt. It appearing to the satisfaction of
Court that the deft both had legal notice of this motion, and
the opinion of the Court being taken, they overruled the said
motion. From which opinion the said plaintiff by his attorney
excepted, and filed his bill of exceptions, which were
signed and sealed by the Court.

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
