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On the motion of James Sundry a witness for Elizabeth Harrison  
by the overseers of the poor against James Sundry, Ordered  
that the said Elizabeth Harrison pay unto the said James Sundry  
fifty three cents for one day's attendance at this Court  
according to Law.

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On the motion of Silas Beal a witness for Benjamin Oonnully  
against William Hart admr of Samuel Hart, Ordered that the said  
Benjamin Oonnully pay unto the said Silas Beal Two Dollars  
and twelve cents for four days attendance at this Court  
according to Law.

ORDERED that the Court be adjourned till To-morrow  
morning nine o'clock.
