It is considered by the Court, that the plt recover
against the deft four pounds nineteen shillings, and
nine pence and his costs by him in this behalf expended

Robert Mabry having obtained an attachment against the
estate of John Williams, who hath privately removed
himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of Law
cannot be served upon him, for nineteen dollars and
forty four cents due by account.

This day came the plt by his attorney, and the Sheriff
making return that he had summoned Ethelbert C
Williams to appear as a garnishee, and the deft not
appearing. It is considered by the Court that the plt
(who proved his acc^t to be just) recover against the deft
the aforesaid sum of nineteen dollars and forty four cents
and his costs by him in this behalf expended - and the
said garnishee appearing, deposed that he hath in his
hands the said sum of nineteen dollars and forty four
cents in C. M. C. Therefore It is ordered that the
said garnishee pay unto the plaintiff the said
sum and costs of this attachment if so much shall
remain in his hands after discharging the claim which
he has against the deft at the time he was summoned
as garnishee in this suit.
