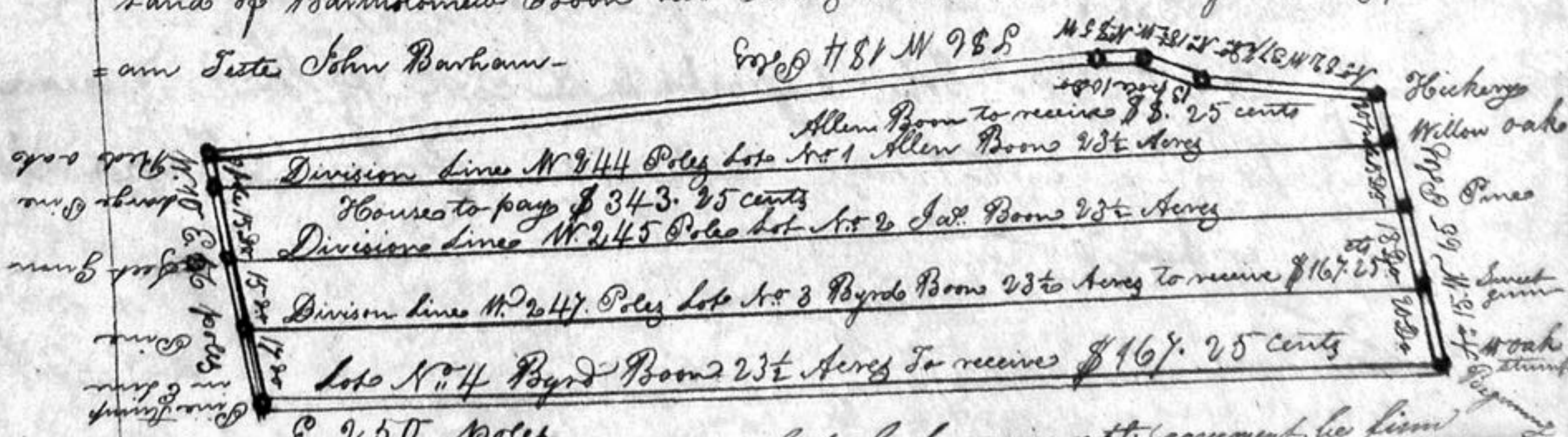

This cause was this day docketed by consent of the parties and absent of the court. And on the motion of the parties it is decreed and ordered that Joel Edwards Lewis Wonell Sion Hill & Benjamin Whitfield or any three of them lay off and divide by proper meters and and bounds the land whereof Bartholomew Boon died seized and possessed and assign one half thereof to Byrd Boon one fourth to James Boon and the remaining fourth to Allen Boon to make report in order to a decree final between the parties.

The persons appointed by the foregoing decree to divide the lands of Bartholomew Boon this day made their report in the following words to wit. Southampton County Feb 23 March 1805. By consent of the legatees and by virtue of an Interlocutory order of Southampton County court we Joel Edwards, Lewis Wonell & Sion Hill appointed by the county Surveyor have had the land of Bartholomew Boon surveyed and divided to wit Beginning at a white oak stump in the Carolina line and running N 15 W 65 Poles a Hickory a corner of said Land and James Boon, in the line of Capt. John Hart Decd. thence N 82 W 3 1/2 Poles to a white oak. Thence N 68 1/2 W 13 Poles to a white oak. Thence N 55 W 10 Poles Thence S 56 W 184 Poles to a Red Oak a corner of James Boon, and said Land in Williamsons line. Thence S 10 E 56 to a pine stump in said Carolina line thence a long S line East 250 poles to the beginning, in all 94 Acres. John Barham D.S. of Richards O. Clements of Joel Edwards, Lewis Wonell, Sion Hill P. & we the under named legatees do agree to stand to the above Division of the Land of Bartholomew Boon wch James Boon, Allen Boon, Byrd Boon for the Cheaters - and Sister John Barham -
