Jesse Godwin, and Thomas Fitzhugh, were brought into court in custody of the Sheriff, under a warrant, the said Jesse for opening a Faro bank and said Thomas for playing and betting thereat contrary to an act of assembly to prevent unlawful gaming, and whereupon it was ordered that the said Jesse & Thomas, find security for their appearances here in court to morrow morning at 10 o'clock to answer the premises and thereupon the said Jesse with John Barber Wm. Johnson & Wm. M. Pooler, his securities, and said Thomas Fitzhugh, with John Crichtlow, his security entered into and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Int. Page Governor of this Commonwealth & to his successors in office for the time being, that is to say, the said Jesse in the sum of one thousand dollars & the said John Barber, Wm. Johnson & Wm. M. Pooler, his securities in the sum of five hundred dollars each, and the said Thomas in the sum of five hundred dollars with John Crichtlow, his security, in the sum of five hundred dollars of their respective lands and tenements, goods and chattels to be levied and to the use of the Commonwealth to be rendered, yet to be void upon this condition that if the said Jesse Godwin & Thomas Fitzhugh shall appear here before the court on tomorrow morning at ten o'clock to abide the judgment of the court, and shall not depart from thence until they shall be therefrom discharged by due course of law and leave of the court.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till to-morrow morning, 9 o'clock
