X It ^{appearing} to the court that Ann Hargrave, widow of Mike Hargrave, who died in the Service of the State is still in indigent circumstances and not able to support herself therefore it is ordered that she be allowed six pounds for her pension -

X It appearing to the satisfaction of the court that Mary Windham, widow of Benj^a Windham who died in the Service of the State is still in indigent circumstances and not able to support herself therefore it is ordered that she be allowed six pounds for her pension -

X On the motion of Samuel Browne for an injunction to stay the proceeding of a judgement at common law claimed against him by Josiah Lawrence, the same is granted him on his giving bond and security. Whereupon the said Samuel Browne, entered into bond & security for his due and faithful prosecution of the aforesaid injunction & paying all costs and damages in case the said injunction should be dissolved.

X It appearing to the court that the license granted to John Denegre to keep a tavern at his house in Jerusalem, was improper; Therefore it is ordered that the order made yesterday be rescinded and that the Sheriff refund to the said John Denegre the sum of twelve collars and fifty cents this tax imposed by law on tavern licenses, which it appears he has paid to the Sheriff.
