

It is therefore considered that the said Henry Parker take nothing by his bill aforesaid but for his false plaintt he thereof in mercy, And the S^r John may go thence without day, And it is further considered that the S^r John recover his costs by him about his defence in this behalf S^r sustained.

From which Judgment and opinion of the court the said Henry prayed an appeal to the next District Court to be holden in the town of Suffolk on the 12 day of October next which is granted him on his giving bond security &c

On the motion of Nathaniel Newsum, as witness for S^r T. Blow &c against Wm Blow. It is ordered that the said Blow pay the said Newsum fifty three cents for one days attendance at this court according to law

On the motion of Allen Jones, as witness for Henry Person, against John Person against Solomon Dawson, It is ordered that the said Person pay the said Jones fifty three cents for one days attendance at this court according to law.

On the motion of Robert Magee, as witness for Charles Harrison, at the suit of Thomas Harrison, against Henry, It is ordered that the said Charles pay the said Robert, fifty three cents for one days attendance at this court according to law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Fells as witness for Charles Harrison, at the suit of Thomas Harrison, against Henry, it is ordered that the said Charles pay the said Nathaniel the sum of fifty three cents for one days attendance at this court according to law.

On the motion of James Vick, as witness for Council Vick, and Bath his wife at the suit of William Newsum, and Nancy his wife, It is ordered that the said Council pay the said James fifty three cents for one days attendance at this court according to law.

On the motion of Thomas Barnes, as witness for Benj^s Newsum at the suit of Nancy Cutler, It is ordered that the said Benjamin Newsum pay the said Thomas Barnes, fifty three cents for one days attendance at this court according to law.
