At a court held for Southampton on the 27th day of October 1811

The Testament and last will of Henry Tiller was this day presented in court by Christians Tiller the testatrix therin named proved by the oath of Mr. Madill, Henshaw & Dentury & William Baldwin the notaries thornto ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executrix who made with according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on her giving bond and security - Whereupon the said Christians Tiller with James Harris and James Wright her trustees intituting and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars for the said Christians due and faithful performance of the said will and administration of the estate.

Ordered that David Myrick Joseph Gilliam Starrett Harris and Christopher or any three of them being first sworn before as Justice of the peace for the county do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Henry Tiller exec^d and return the appraisement to court -

Indenture of bargain and sale between Elizabeth Turner of the one part and Ephraim Tress of the other part was acknowledged by the said Elizabeth party hereto and ordered to be recorded -

The Testament and last will of Nathaniel Scott exec^d was this day presented in court by Mary Scott the testatrix therin named proved by the oath of Nathaniel Foster Edmund Cotton and James P. Ross the notaries thornto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executrix who made with according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on her giving bond and security - Whereupon the said Mary Scott with Nathaniel Foster and John Card her trustees intituting and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars for the performance of his will and administration of the estate
