This cause was this day decided by consent of parties and agreed of the court. Heard on the bill of the complainant answer of the defendant and argument of counsel whereupon the court do decree and order that James Harris John Harris David Diggle and Abraham Harris or any three of them being attended by the county surveyor do lay off by proper mete and bounds and apportion to the complainant James Teller one tract of land containing two hundred acres calling the old tract and one other tract of land containing one hundred and fifty acres calling and known by the name of Boob (which said lands was devised by Major Teller by his last will and testament to his grand son James Teller after the death of his father Henry Teller) and make report thereof to the court in order to a final decree

A Dec of Gift between Thomas Vaughan Sen^r of the one part and Martha Ann Vaughan daughter of Thomas Vaughan Sen^r of the other part was acknowledged by the said Thomas Vaughan Sen^r party hereto and ordered to be recorded -

An Indenture of bargain and Sale between John Lee and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and Richmond Dillard of the other part was proved by the oath of Jacob Darden barn Darden and Jordan Williams for the witness thereto and with a commission for the proving examination of M^r Lee and a certificate of its execution returned as ordered to be recorded -
