

The person appointed by a decree of this court to make distribution of the estate of Lazarus Cook died this day before this report in the following work to execute  
 in Southampton County for his conformity to a decree of the court of the county above  
 we have assigned to Elizabeth Cook her donee in the land and negroes of her late  
 husband Lazarus Cook in and to the several distributees their proportionable share  
 of the negroes of the slaves of the said Lazarus Cook as follows: To Elizabeth  
 Cook as her third part of the negroes plantation, we assign her two  
 negroes the following named. Beginning at a tree in Roger Gray's line;  
 thence South 78 degrees west 360 feet to a small branch, thence the same course  
 of the branch till it enters into the little swamp, thence along the latter  
 swamp to Tararua creek, thence along this creek to the road, thence  
 along the road South two degrees and 105 pole to a post & corner in the line  
 of the infant children of Nathaniel Edwards, thence an east 320 pole to  
 the creek aforesaid, thence up the creek to the mouth of the mill swamp;  
 thence up the swamp to Sommers' Mile, thence up the mill pond to Roger  
 Gray's line, thence along his line north 85 degrees west ninety pole to the  
 beginning - and as her third part of the tract lying east of Sommers'  
 Mile we assign her the following, Beginning at a poplar in John  
 Limmons' line, thence South 45 degrees east 68 pole to a pine, thence  
 south 5 degrees east 88 pole to a branch in Sally Everett's line, thence  
 north 75 degrees east 54 pole to a young standing in the said branch,  
 thence along the branch to a post oak 2 corners of Charles Bryant;  
 thence north 39 degrees west ninety six poles to an oak stump, thence 70 poles  
 to a pine & corner in Miles Cook's line, thence along a line of marker  
 trees to the beginning - as her third part of the negroes of the said estate  
 we assign the following, Hamm, Anna, Willie, Shirley, Emily, Lucy, Hila  
 Ness, Rachel of Barbary, one fifth part of the negroes of the negroes we  
 assign to Lawrence Cook, to wife Lucy Black Cook of Eliza - To Miles  
 Cook, we assign a his distributive share of the negroes, Luke, Biles &  
 Mingo - To Peter D. Pierce, in right of Fanny his wife we assign  
 Sarah Motley of Nelson - To Joshua Cook in right of his wife Martha  
 - from H.D. Nancy by Alfred - To Patsy Day Fanny Day
