 conformably to a decree of the court of the county aforesaid, we have made
 the following distribution of the land of which Lazarus Cook died seised
 among the contributors as follows; We assign to Patsy Day, Fanny Day, Emily

 Beginning at the mouth of the little Swamp, from thence to the mouth of
 the main branch, thence along the main branch to a gum standing
 there; thence a straight line to a hickory, a corner in Henry & Sons
 line; thence a straight line to a gum & corner in Kinners line
 thence along Kinners line and the line of Bens. Hays to a stake on
 Hays line; thence along Elizabeths hickory line to the beginning

 Cook the infant children of Nathaniel Edwards, Joshua Fort & Peter
 Pierce. We assign to Peter B. Pierce in right of his wife Fanny, one
 hundred and fifty four acres, by survey and bounded by the land of John
 Fort, James Dyer and those of the estate of Bodwell Neplest v. -
 We assign to Joshua Fort in right of his wife Patsy, two hundred
 and nine acres, bounded by the land of Laurence Cook, Peter B. Pierce
 William Phelps, and the infant children of Nathaniel Edwards.
