 Polly Edwards, formerly Cook, we assigned the remaining sixth part
 to wits Betty, Winney, Allow of Nat, they paying to Laurence Cook forty
 four pounds two shillings. Given under our hand this February 1733.

 conformably to a decree of the court of the county aforesaid, we have made
 the following distribution of the land of which Laurence Cook died seignior
 among the distributees as follow; We assign to Peter Day, Fanny Day, Anne
 Day and John Day, in right of their mother Betty Day, the following tract
 beginning at the mouth of the little branch, from thence to the mouth of
 the main branch, thence along the main branch to a gum standing
 there; thence a straight line to a hickory, a corner in Hand of
 line; thence a straight line to a gum a corner in kinders line
 thence along kinders line and the line of Bens Hoy to a oak on
 Hoy line; thence along Elizabeths hickory line to the beginning
 containing by survey two hundred and three acres they paying to
 Laurence Cook, twenty one pounds, twelve shillings and nine pence.
 We assign to Laurence Cook, by survey one hundred and thirty eight
 land bounded by the line of the estate of Roberts Neffert, Edw
 Cook the infant children of Nathaniel Edwards, Richard Fort & Peter
 Pierce. We assign to Peter B. Pierce in right of his wife Fanny
 hundred and fifty four acres, by survey and bounded by the land of
 Fort, James Dyer and those of the estate of Roberts Neffert &c.
 We assign to Richard Fort in right of his wife Patsy, two hundred
 and nine acres, bounded by the land of Laurence Cook, Peter B. Pierce
 William Phillips, and the infant children of Nathaniel Edwards.
 We assign to Polly Edwards, Patsy Edwards, Lucretia Edwards, Nathaniel
 Edwards, Frank Edwards & John Edwards, infant children of
