George W Smith Governor of the Commonwealth and his Successors in
office for the time being in the sum of three hundred and thirty four
dollars and thirty four cents for themselves and the said Thomas Martin
in the further sum of three hundred and thirty four cents for the
said John Martin to his heirs of them and proper goods and chattels and
instruments to the use of the Commonwealth under and upon the
conditions that if the said Thomas Puggin Thomas Martins & John Martin
do personally appear before the Judges of our Superior Court to be taken
for this county on the 7th day of April next then and thence to give
such testimony as they and each of them know and believe of it is
commonwealth against Joseph Lane who stands charged with murder
and shall not depart without leave of the court
