

Be it remembered that James Capell and Silvia Barnes personally appeared into court and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to James Parbour Esq; governor of this Commonwealth and his successors in office for the time being that is to say the sum of James Capell in the sum of <sup>three hundred</sup> thirty three dollars and thirty four cents & the said Silvia Barnes in the sum of three hundred and thirty two dollars and thirty four cents of their respective last governments personal chattels to be levied and to the use of the Commonwealth to be rendered yet to be paid on this condition that is to say I the said James Capell of the Towne shall personally appear before the Judge of our Superior at the courthouse of this county on the last day of April next by ten o'clock of that day then and there to give such testimony as they and each of them know against William Byrd who stands committed for grand larceny & shall not report without leave of this court
