

Be it reminding that James Caple and Silvia Gardner personally appeared into court and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to James Harbour Esquire governor of this commonwealth and his successors in office for the time being that is to say the said James Caple in the sum of ^{three hundred} thirty three dollars and thirty four cents of the said Silvia Gardner in the sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty four cents of their respective land & tenements and chattels to be sued and to the use of the commonwealth to be recovered yet to be void and this condition that is to say if the said James Caple & the Turner shall personally appear before the Judge of our Superior at the courthouse of this county on the last day of April next by two o'clock of that day then and there to give such testimony as they and each of them know against William Byrd who stands committed for grand larceny and there not report without leave of the court

Ordered that Jacob Byrnes, William Byrnes & Henry Byrnes or any two of them as examiners shall take the account current of Nicholas Bond and report to the court
