Henry Bailey and Samuel Calvert are by the court recommended to be jobbers to be coroners of this county to supply the vacancy in that office occasioned by the resignation of James Rockwell, late coroner of this county.

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Ordered that the owners of the poor of this county so bind out William Boyal a poor slave according to Law.

Ordered that Henry Briggs administrator with the will annexed of Samuel Calvert sen. be summoned to the next court to render said Samuel's account with the county or collection of the county levy.

Thomas Holladay of this county sen. being intestate proprietor of a small estate in which no person will administer since the death of Benjamin Roberts former owner of said Thomas. It is ordered that the sheriff of this county take the said estate into his hands and enforce thereof as the law directs and return an account to the court.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till court in June
