An Indenture of bargain and sale between Samuel Blunt and Mary his wife of the one part and John V. Wilkes of the other part was acknowledged by Saml Blunt and Mary his wife before two justices of the peace for this county in pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided with a certificate thereof returned as aforesaid to be recorded.

Ordered that the owners of the poor for this county do send out Maundy day and Lenten day of Henry Henry Hearn poor children according to law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Plunk who made oath according to law and together with John Nicholas and James Hillier of his Decretes entered into and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs satisfactorily granted the said Nathaniel Plunk for obtaining letters of administration of the estate of Robert Hillier Esq. and due for same.

Ordered that Samuel Plunk Thomas Vaughan Esq. Alfred Bennett and John Lee or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appear in court every the slaves of any and personal estate of Robert Hillier Esq. and return the appraisement to court.

The last will and testament of Joseph Bart Esq. was proved by the oaths of John Bart Esq. Puffin Bart two of the witnesses thereto and is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of John Holliman and John Bart the executor therein named entered into and acknowledging to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof and due from on their giving bond and security whereupon the said John Holliman Joseph Bart with Peter Booth Bus Hammett Executors of Decretes of James Worthington three securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Alfred Bailey Anthony Andrews Richard Bart and Benjamin Moberg two or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appear in court every the slaves of any and personal estate of Joseph Bart Esq. and return the appraisement to court.
