made and provided and with a certificate thereof returned is ordered to be recorded -

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Samuel Blunt and Mary his
wife of the one part and John V. Miller of the other part was acknowledged by Sam
Blunt and Mary his wife, further that she being first privately examined at the
law courts and allowed to her certificate to the county court of Prince George for and
Emanuel Branch who was heretofore appointed constable in the upper parish of Dule
and parish therewith George Branch and John Holloman his securities entered into
and acknowledge their bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned
as the law directs -

Ordered that the Owner of the poor for this county, so bind out Matthew Long and
Rebecca Adams & Henry Henry Adams, poor children according to law

On the motion of Nathaniel Bowles who made oath according to law, and together
with Nat McAllister and James Miller his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond
in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certifying granted
the said Nathaniel Bowles for obtaining letters of administration of the estate of Robert
Miller see record and sue found -

Ordered that Samuel Blunt, Thomas Vaughan, Dr. Alfred Powell and Jos
Lee or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for this county
so appear in court and manumit the slaves of any and personal estates of Robert Miller
and return the apprenticeship to court

The last will and testament of Joseph East no^d was proved by the oaths of John H. F.
Puffin Back two of the witnesses thereto and is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion
of John Holloman and John Lee that the spectators therein named acknowledge and return,
to law certificate as grants them for obtaining a probate thereof in case from on their
giving, lend and security whereupon the said John Holloman Joseph East with the
Rest his Heirs, Executrix & Personalty of Anne Washington these securities entered
into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars conditioned as
the law directs -

Ordered that Alfred Bailey, Anthony Andrews, Richard East and Benjamin Waring
or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for this county
so appear in court and manumit the slaves of any and personal estates of Joseph East
and return the apprenticeship to court

The Commonwealth on behalf of Jonathan Little against Peter Fabre upon a recogniz
