

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Samuel Torrey & Michael Harris and Edward Phillips & messengers appointed to make sale of the lands of William Drury re: of the one part and Edmund Drury of the other part was acknowledged by said Edward Torrey, Michael Harris, Henry Phillips parties thereto and sealed to be recorded.

On the motion of Jordan Williams, for administration on the estate of Isaac O'Holland re: (who made oath according to law) certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on said estate on his giving bond with approved standing legal bondsmen widow and child of said Isaac O'Holland, by certificate under his hand and seal relinquishing all his right of administration, whereupon said Jordan Williams with James Hays and Isaac Gardner his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Four thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Peter Love, James Love, Arthur Love, and Jordan Williams, Sen: or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for this county or otherwise in competent money the Slaves of any and personal estate of Isaac O'Holland re: and return the appointment to court.

On the motion of Nancy Pluff for administration on the estate of John Pluff re: (who made oath according to law) the same is granted her on her giving bond and security, whereupon husband Nancy Pluff with John Barham and David Matthews her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Eight thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Joel Matthews, Humphrey Drury, Ramon Harwell, and Joseph Hildreth or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for this county or otherwise in competent money the Slaves of any and personal estate of John Pluff re: and return the appointment to court.

Ordered that the owners of the poor for this county do send out Edward Spear & his family, John Oulbacks poor children and Bob Green, Henry Demand & Daniel Purney per negr children according to law.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the court that John Hargrave is yet being and in indigent circumstances, therefore it is ordered that she be allowed by pounds for her provision for the present year.

Edward Botte who was hitherto appointed com: supervisor of the revenues for the parishes of Stortow and county of Southampton, then personally appeared in court, his wife Mary, Anne and Benjamin, both his securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, whereupon the said Edward Botte qualified according to law.
