

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Edmund Torrey & Michael Harris and Edward Phillips & Henry Jones appointed to make sale of the land of William Drury viz. of the one part and Edmund Drury of the other part was acknowledged by said Edmund Torrey, Michael Harris, Henry Phillips parties thereto and sealed to be recorded.

On the motion of Nancy Phillips for administration on the estate of John Phillips viz. who made oath according to law, the same is granted her on her giving bond and security, whereupon said Nancy Phillips with John Barham and David Matlock her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Eight thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Joel Matlock, Humphrey Drury, Hannous Harwell, and Joseph Bland or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for this county as appraisers in current money the Slaves, if any and personal estate of John Phillips viz. and return the appraisement to court.

Ordered that the owners of the poor for this county, viz. bind out Susan Spear and John Davis, John Delbanks poor children and Bob Green, Henry Omand & Daniel Purnum per magis children according to law.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the court that John Hargrave is yet living and in indigent circumstances, therefore it is ordered that he be allowed by pounds for his portion for the present year.

Edward Butts who was heretofore appointed Commissioner of the revenues for the parishes of Stortow and county of Southampton, this day personally appeared in court, he with George Kane and Benjamin both his securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, whereupon the said Edward Butts qualified according to law.
