Ordered that John Thomas, Isaac Mifflin, James Bishop and Benjamin Whitchell, or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Beale esq; and return the appraisement to the court.

An Indenture of Lagan and Sale between John Lawrence, Esquire of Fincastle, in the County of one part and Henry Lively of the other part was acknowledged by said John Lawrence party thereto and agreed to be record.
