On the motion of Bailey Bryant who made oath according to law for administration on the estate of William Underwood &c. the same is granted him on his giving bond and security whereupon the said Bailey Bryant with Nathan Pope and Clark William the Deputies entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that James Powell John Whithead Henry Peter and Benjamin Davis or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Underwood &c. and return the appraisement to the court.

Elizabeth Harris is by the court appointed guardian to Sally and George Westbrock orphan of John Westbrock &c. and therefore the said Elizabeth Harris with Samuel Turner and Coraell Prouty entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars with conditions according to law.

William Hays guardian of Westbrock's heirs procured an account of said orphan's estate which account was returned and allowed by the court. Dooms to by the guardian and same to be recorded.
