One other bond in like manner for one seventh part made payable to the respondent Elizabeth Edwards and that they divide the remaining seventh part of the amount of sales into three equal parts and take one bond with approved security for one third of the last mentioned seventh part payable to the respondent George Edwards, one other bond in like manner for one third of the said one seventh part payable to the respondent Martha Edwards, and one other bond in like manner for the remaining one third of the one seventh part payable to
