return the appraisement to court.

of them do after giving reasonable public notice of the decree open to public sales
a tract of twelve months the parcel or lot of land lying in this county of which the late

bord from the purchase or purchases with good security payable to the complainant
George Edward but for one seventh part of the amount of the sale of the said parcel

payable to the complainant David Stevens, or right of his wife Lucy, one other bord
in like manner for one seventh part more payable to the complainant Ann Barnes,
one other bord in like manner for one seventh part more payable to John Thomas guardian
to the complainants Thomas H. Edwards, Priscilla Edwards and Jordan Edwards one other
bord in like manner for one seventh part more payable to the defendant Elizabeth Edwards and
that they divide the remaining seventh part of the amount of sales into three equal parts
and take one bord with approved security for one third of the last mentioned seventh part
payable to the defendant George Edwards, one other bord in like manner for one third
of the said one seventh part payable to the defendant Martha Edwards and one other
bord in like manner for the remaining one third of the one seventh part payable to
