 hundred acres and by the answer of the Defendants Ruthew Williams and Barwell  
 Williams, that they severally received from their said father Cooper Williams in his lifetime  
 an advancement of a tract or parcel of land lying in the said County of Southampton which  
 they are now unwilling to bring into and to hold fast, preferring rather to let the said  
 respective advancements stand in position with the other children of the said Cooper  
 Williams deceased Therefore it is adjuged, ordered and decreed by the Court that Dennis  
 Cold, Benjamin Devaney, Richard D Williams and John Moore or any three of them
