This Cause was this day docketed by consent of the parties and the effect of the plaint and
was heard on the bill, the opinion of the defendants and the arguments of counsel. Whereupon the
Court after adjudge over and done that Lewis Morell Edwin Baynes, Williamson Edwards and Drew
Barrett or any three of them attested by the Surveyor of Litchfield County, as attel and set apart to
the defendant Mary Edwards widow and relict of Isab Edwards deceased for the time of her natural
life, one third part of the land of which the said Isab Edwards was seized in the said County, also
know thence, having regard in the said allotment as well to the quality of the said land as to
the quantity thereof, sue that they divide with the like regard respectively as well as quantity the
remaining two third parts of the said land equally between the complainant Anerson Edwards and
the defendants Williamson Edwards, James Bascom in right of his wife Sally, Peterson
Edwards, William Bowe in right of his deceased mother Nancy Bowe, Nathan Edwards, Nevil Edwards
and Polly Edwards that the said complainants or any three of them as also all sue set apart to the said
Mary Edwards widow and relict of the said Isab Edwards and for the said Term of her natural life
one third part of the following slaves to wit, Martin Giles, Leah, Hannah, B., Ruth and Eliza
of which the said Isab Edwards was possessed, as her slaves thereunto, sue that they sell the remaining
two third parts of the said slaves at public auction on a credit of twelve months giving reasonable
notice of the time and place of sale and requiring bond or bonds with approved security from the
purchaser or purchasers that they divide the proceeds of the sale of the said slaves equally
between the complainant Anerson Edwards and the said defendants Williamson Edwards, James
Bascom in right of his wife Sally, Peterson Edwards, William Bowe in right of his deceased mother
Nancy Bowe, Nathan Edwards, Nevil Edwards and Polly Edwards letting care to pay the proportion
of the said infant defendants, William Bowe, Nathan Edwards, Nevil Edwards and Polly Edwards
to their respective Guardians, if any, if not, while the said proportion subject to the further order
of this Court. It is further ordered that the said complainants make a report of this action and
do it in this behalf to the Court in view to a final Decree -
