 parts and take one bond with approved security for one third of the said last mentioned
 twelfth part payable to the defendant George Rewards, one other bond in like
 manner for one third of the said one twelfth part payable to the defendant
 Martha Rewards and one other bond in like manner for the remaining one
 third of the said one twelfth part payable to John Moore for the benefit for the
 defendant Sally Moore, Catharine Moore, Elizabeth, John R Moore, and Henry
 H Moore and it is further ordered, that the aforesaid persons do execute a good and
 sufficient deed of conveyance in fee simple to the purchaser or purchasers of the
 said parcels or bill of lading and that they make a report to their Court of their
 doings and savings herein in order to a final Decree -
