On the motion of Jesse Holt for a reimbursement of the tax and interest on a tract of land which he owned previous to the first day of January 1812. It is ordered that he have judgment for \$7.56 the tax and damages paid by him on a tract of land returned in the name of Henry Hayes for the non payment of taxes for the year 1798 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present.

On the motion of Brittain Travis for a reimbursement of the money paid by him on a tract of land which he owned previous to the first day of January 1812. It is ordered that he have judgment for Seven dollars and forty cents the taxes and damages paid by him on a tract of land returned in the name of Mary Haugrave for the non payment of taxes for the years 1797 and 1798 and a tract of land returned in the name of John Wincham for the year 1798 and in the name of Peter Wincham for the year 1799 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present.

On the motion of Lewis Morrell for reimbursement of the money paid by him on a tract of land which he owned previous to the first day of January 1812. It is ordered that he have judgment for the following sums to wit two dollar and one cent for the tax and damages on a tract of land returned in the name of John Wincham for the year 1806 and one dollar and twenty nine cents the taxes and damages on a tract of land returned in the name of Nathan Morrell in the year 1806 and Two dollars and thirty two cents for the tax and damages on a tract of land returned in the name of Elizabeth Morrell for the years 1805 and 1806 and Three dollars and forty six cents the tax and interest on a tract of land returned in the name of Job and Nicholas Abbotson for the years 1805 and 1806.
