James Schelle Story and Willis due to pay Nancy Schelle \$42.25 also have due payment
 Schelle Henderson Party and Childs Edwards due to pay Nancy Schelle \$60.00 due we have also
 assigned to Nancy Schelle Story or making each child's proportion \$452.25 There is a Negro man
 Dennis belonging to the estate now living in former pauperage for his present but it is sufficient
 that he ought not to be brought in the administration of the estate who said Negro Dennis is in
 the hands of the guardians of the said children known under our hands this 10th day of Decem
 ber Eighteen hundred and eleven George Dennis, Michael Ellis, John Lamourous Whereupon
 it is ordered and enacted that the vision made as aforesaid be held free and stale forever
 and that the costs be proportionately borne between the Parties.

On the motion of Jose Holt for a reimbursement of the tax and interest on a tract of land
 which he owned previous to the first day of January 1812 ordered that he have judgment for
 \$75 to the tax and damages paid by him on a tract of land returned in the name of Henry Sage
 for the non-payment of taxes for the years 1797 and 1798 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present

On the motion of Captain Davis for a reimbursement of the money paid by him on a tract of
 land which he owned previous to the first day of January 1812 It is ordered that he have judgment
 for Seven dollars and forty cents the tax and damages paid by him on a tract of land returned
 in the name of Mary Hargrave for the non-payment of taxes for the years 1797 and 1798 and
 a tract of land returned in the name of John Wincham for the year 1793 and in the
 name of Peter Wincham for the year 1799 The Attorney for the Commonwealth being present

On the motion of Lewis Morell for reimbursement of the money paid by him on a tract of
 land which he owned previous to the first day of January 1812 It is ordered that he have
 judgment for the following sum to wit, one dollar and one cent for the tax and damage on a
 tract of land returned in the name of John Brusham for the year 1806 and one dollar and
 twenty nine cents the tax and damage on a tract of land returned in the name of Nathan
 Morell in the year 1806 and two dollars and thirty five cents for the tax and damage on a
 tract of land returned in the name of Elizabeth Morell for the years 1815 and 1816 and
 three dollars and forty six cents the tax and interest on a tract of land returned in the name of
 Joel and Nicholas Robeson for the years 1815 and 1816 — The Attorney for the Commonwealth
 being present
