A Deed in Trust between John Johnson of the first part Augustus Hope of the second part and William Dore of the third part was proved in the Clerk's Office by the said John Johnson one of the Subscribing witnesses thereto and accounted as the law directs in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly entitled an act to amend an act entitled an act for regulating conveyances and was presented in Court and ordered to be continued for further proof.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between John Smith and Nancy his wife of the one part and John James of the other part with a receipt thereon executed was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office of this County and duly accounted in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly entitled an act to amend an act entitled an act for regulating conveyances and with a commission for the jury examination of the said Nancy Smith wife of the said John, and a certificate of its execution being returned is ordered to be entered of record.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Elizabeth Bratt and Elizabeth her wife of the one part and David M. Ritter of the other part was proved in the Clerk's Office by the said Elizabeth Bratt one of the Subscribing witnesses thereto and duly accounted in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided and with a commission for the jury examination of the said Elizabeth Bratt and a certificate of its execution returned is continued for further proof.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Thomas Gray of the one part and Samuel of the other part was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office by Thomas Gray party thereto and duly accounted in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided is ordered to be entered of record.
