Ordered that James Scamwell, John Chappell, Benjamin Pitt and Frederick Pitts or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Kinn deceased and return the appraisement to the Court —

Ordered that Isaac Walton, John Pitts, Peter Walton and John Avant or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate in this County do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Kinn deceased (in that County) and the County of Brunswick after having been sworn before a magistrate of that County and return the appraisement to this Court —

Samuel & Boykin is by the Court appointed Guardian to Miley and Whitehead orphans of William Whitehead deceased who together with James Blayton and John Whitehead his securities entered into and acknowledge their bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars with condition as the law directs —
