Ordered that Henry Thomas, John Thomas, Thomas Vaughan & and John Brooker or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Henry Blaw deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of Simon Murfee who made oath due together with John Barnes his Secuties interest into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Thirty Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of David Edwards deceased in due form.

Ordered that William Edwards, William Murfee, Hadrock Vaughan and Abington Edwards or any three of them, being first sworn before a magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of David Edwards deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

The last will and Testament of Dudley Barrell deceased was proved by the oath of John Munson and Matthew Withay two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be read back on the motion of James Jones and Nathan Bowring the executor therein named who made oath thereto due together with Benjamin Wilson their Secuties interest into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.

Ordered that William Soyner, John Lambford, Benjamin Wilson and Joshua Gabel or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Dudley Barrell deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of James Newman who made oath due together with Simon Murfee and Samuel Murfee his Secuties interest into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Matthew <sup>Manfred</sup> deceased in due form.
