On the motion of James Murfee who made oath and together with Jesse Newsum his Secutary entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of David Edwards deceased in due form.

Ordered that William Edwards, William Murfee, Joshua Vaughan and Abington Edwards or any three of them, being first sworn before a magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of David Edwards deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

The last will and testament of Dudley Barrett deceased was proved by the oath of John Hanson and Matthew Widray two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be read back on the motion of James Jones and Nathan Bowring the executors therein named who made oath thereto and together with Benjamin Wilson their Secutary entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted them for obtaining a probal thereof in due form.

Ordered that William Soyner, Jesse Lambford, Benjamin Wilson and Joshua Gabel or any three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Dudley Barrett deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of James Newsum who made oath and together with James Murfee and Benjamin Murfee his Secutaries entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of ^{Administ} administration on the estate of Matthew ^{deceased} in due form.
