Therefore on the return of David Hargreaves she made oath and together with Griffin Tette his security entered into and acknowledged as the penalty of Three hundred dollars bond conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the said deceased's estate in due form.

Ordered that Arthur Williamson, Thomas Williamson, & Abner Williamson, being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Aaron Sharp deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of Abner Reese she made oath and together with Thomas Applewhite and George Key, his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Sally Reese dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Benjamin Ives, Thomas Bate, Lewis Reese, Joseph Reese dec'd and Anne Reese or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Sally Reese deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of Henry Tette she made oath and together with Thomas Pope and William Copell his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Four Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Randolph Tette deceased in due form.

Ordered that Nathaniel Fates, Joel Lee, Abraham Nicklson and Eliza Nicklson or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County, do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of Randolph Tette deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

On the motion of Selary Turner she executing names in the last will and Testament of Joseph Turner deceased, his late husband, who made oath thereto and together with James Jackson and Richard Harrison & his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form. Liberty is reserved for the Executors in the said will named to join in the probat when they shall think fit.

John Harris Sr who is charged on oath by Elizabeth Ann Harrison in this County single Woman with being the father of her bastard Child and stands bound by a recognizance to appear here and shew by and perform the order of this Court concerning the same and the said Defendant being solemnly called and not appearing. It is noted that this prosecution be continued till the next Court.
