This cause comes on this day by consent of the parties and order of the Court to be heard on the bill and answer and exhibits and arguments of counsel thereupon. The consideration thereof has the Court with own advice and decree that Henry Thomas, John Thomas, John Blaw and George Gurley or any two or more the crops and stock of which the Testator Henry Blaw did possess into three equal parts and assign one of the same to the Complainant, to her during her natural life and that they or any two do also divide the negroes of which the said Henry Blaw did possess having regard to value into three equal parts taking care to place such negroes as the said Complainant may choose in one lot and assign the same to her for and during her natural life and that they make a report to the Court in order to a final Decree.

On the motion of William Mace, Master in Chancery, It is ordered that ~~James~~ William Newton, Guardian of Percy Powell orphan of ~~second~~ is summoned him to the next Court to render an account of his guardianship on the said orphan estate.

John Wiggins orphan of William Wiggins second made choice with the approbation of the Court, of John Brown for his guardian who together with John Corbett and Arthur M. Carr his committee entered into and acknowledge their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned according to law.
