

At a Court continued and held for the County of Southampton the 17th day of January 1814
one thousand eight hundred and fifteen

Present — Samual Holt, Lawrence Holt — Justices
George R. Holt and George Surley —

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court as surveyors of the lands and houses
whereof Benjamin Turner was seized and piped this day make their report in the words and
figures following to wit, — Agreeable to an order of the County Court of Southampton is as entered
bearing date January 1814 We have gone on the lands of Benjamin Turner deceased and now out
and divided the same being enclosed with the County Surveyor as by the plan we were required
having regard to quality as well as quantity, in manner and form as will appear by the annexed
Plan to this report, 1st to wit, Beginning at a large green fence a new corner made in Samuel
Turner and James Barrett lots N^o 1 and 2 running thence N. 57. 2. 32 pole to a corner on the line
thence N. 74. 2. 84 pole to a small black gum a Co. of John Whitehead, thence due north 55 pole
to a white oak a Co. of John Turner thence N. 85. 17. 44 pole, thence due North 8 pole to a
Sapling a new corner made in Lots N^o 1 and 2 and from thence S. 86 pole to the 1st Station
being Lot N^o 1 containing 57 Acres which lot was drawn by Samuel Turner who is to pay to
John Turner Lot N^o 4 50 dollars being Samuel Turner's full proportionable part of said lands
Thence Beginning at a small scrub oak bush a new corner made in Lots N^o 1 and 2
running N. 74. 2. 84 pole to the road, thence along the road the various houses thence to a pine
a new corner made in Lots N^o 2 and 3, thence S. 47. 2. 58 pole to a pine a Co. of Samuel
Turner and from thence N. 57. 2. 65 pole to the first Station being Lot N^o 2 containing 50
Acres which lot was drawn by James Barrett in right of his wife who is
to pay to Samuel Turner Lot N^o 5 14 dollars being James Barrett's proportionable part of
the said lands in right of his wife —
Thence Beginning at the road as aforesaid running thence N. 55. 17. 100 pole to a line a new corner
made in Lots N^o 3 and 4 thence due South 105 pole to a small tree standing in hawthorn branch
a new corner made between Samuel Turner and John Turner's Lots N^o 3 and 4 thence N. 74. 2. 84
pole to a pine in hawthorn branch, thence South 25. 2. 65 pole to the first Station being
Lot N^o 3 containing 71 Acres which lot was drawn by Samuel Turner who is to receive
from James Barrett's lot N^o 2 fourteen dollars proportionable part of said lands —
Thence Beginning at a pine a new corner made in Lots N^o 3 and 4 running thence S. 76. 17. 100
pole to a pine a corner in the meadow down line thence S. 86. 17. 100 pole to a corner in meadow
thence along the meadow to the mill pond and thence along the mill pond to a post oak
thence South 50. 2. 84 pole to the 1st Station — being Lot N^o 4 containing 105 Acres which
lot was drawn by John Turner who is to receive from Samuel Turner Lot N^o 1 Twenty
dollars being his proportionable part of said lands — The same Deeds further containing
as to make a division of the lands belonging to the said Deeds it appearing that as no
equal division can be made in kind amongst the legatees, We have proceeded to make
sale of — same as followeth, on a credit of twelve months —
