

At a Court held and held for the County of Southampton the 17th day of January
one thousand eight hundred and fifteen -

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court as Surveyor of the lands and slaves
whereof Benjamin Turner late Surveyor and Fifer this day presented report in the words and
figures following to wit - - - - - Agreeable to an order of the County Court of Southampton to an order
bearing date January 1814 we have gone on the lands of Benjamin Turner deceased and run out
and divided the same being attended with the County Surveyor as by the sum we were required
having regard to quality as well as quantity, in manner and form as will appear by the survey
plat to this report, S. 1st to N. 4th. Beginning at a large group of trees a new corner made in Samuel
Turner and James Barrett lots No. 1 and 2 running thence N. 37. 2. 32 pole to a corner on the line
thereof N. 74. 2. 84 pole to a small black tree a C. of John Whitehead thence due north 55 pole
to a white oak a C. of John Turner House N. 85. 17. 4 pole thence due North 8 pole to a
sapling a new corner made in Lots No. 1 and 2 east from thence S. 6. 16 pole to the 1st Station
being Lott No. 1 containing 58 Acres which lot was drawn by Samuel Turner, who is to pay to
John Turner Lott No. 4 40 dollars being Samuel Turners full proportionable part of said lands
- - - - - Thence Beginning at a small scrub oak bush a new corner made in lots No. 1 and 2
running N. 84. 1. 06 pole to the road, thence along the road the various bounds thereof to a pine
a new corner made in lots No. 2 and 3, thence S. 47. 2. 38 pole to a pine a C. of Samuel
Turner and from thence N. 57. 2. 65 pole to the first Station being Lott No. 2 containing 55
Acres which lot was drawn by James Barrett in right of his wife who is
to pay to Samuel Turner Lott No. 3 14 dollars being James Barretts proportionable part of
the said lands in right of his wife - - - - -

Thence Beginning at the road as aforesaid running thence N. 85. 17. 4 pole to a line a new corner
made in lots No. 3 and 4 thence due South 15 pole to a small tree standing in bass branch
a new corner made between Bassett and Turner and John Turners lots No. 3 and 4 thence N. 57.
2. 65 pole to a pine in bass branch, thence South 25. 2. 65 pole to the first Station being
Lott No. 3 containing 71 Acres which lot was drawn by Bassett Turner who is to receive
from James Barrett Lott No. 2 fourteen dollars Proportionable part of said lands - - - - -

Thence Beginning at a pine a new corner made in lots No. 3 and 4 running thence S. 47. 2. 38
pole to a pine a corner in the river down line thence S. 6. 16 West 13. 2 pole to a cane measure
thence along the meadow to the mill pond and thence along the mill pond to a post oak
thence South 58. 2. 52 pole to the 1st Station - - - - - being Lott No. 4 containing 105 Acres which
lot was drawn by John Turner who is to receive from Samuel Turner Lott No. 1 forty
dollars being his proportionable part of said lands - - - - - The same Deed further authorizing
us to make a division of the slaves belonging to the said deceased & appearing to us as an
equal division can be made in kind amongst the legatees, we have proceeded to make
said division as follows, on a credit of twelve months - - - - -
