On the motion of John Dorem who made oath and together with Jacob Dorem and Simon Hubler his Sureties entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of their hundred Dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Robert Johnson deceased in due form.

Ordered that Mills Claffer, Richard Claffer, Simon Hubler, James Mills and William Edwards, or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County, do appraise in correct money the value of any and personal estate of Robert Johnson deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

Ordered that Buffin Smith, John Dorem and James Harrison, or any two of them as executors State and settle the account of the administration of the estate of Jacob Mills deceased and make a report thereof to the Court.

Peter Blow who the Court appointed an overseer of the poor in the upper District and who presented the power of Council Blount who has disqualified himself by accepting of an appointment from the United States of America and it is ordered that the said Peter Blow be summoned to the next Court to qualify as such according to law.

Bryant Blount one of the executors named in the last will and Testament of Henry Blow deceased. This day here in Court refusing to take upon himself the burden of the executors thereof. On the motion of the said Bryant Blount who made oath and together with Samuel Blount and James Harris his Sureties entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Fifty Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the said deceased estate with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.

The last will and Testament of William Jones deceased was proved by the oaths of James Rochelle, William B. Goodwin and John Smith the witnesses thereto and is ordered to be recorded. The Executor therein named refuses to take upon himself the burden of the executors thereof, on the motion of James B. Jones who made oath and together with Samuel Blount, James Trogant, John Smith and Buffin Smith his Sureties entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Twenty Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the said deceased estate with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.
