

Benjamin Bell this day produced to the Court a certificate of his having qualified
as a Magistrate, as follows: Commenced of the 65th Regiment of this County
Virginia Militia which is ordered to be entered of record.

James Trogant produced to the Court this day a commission from the Governor
of Virginia appointing him a Major District in the 65th
Regiment of Virginia Militia of this County, and qualified there according to
Law which is ordered to be entered of record.

On the motion of John Dorem who made oath and together with Jacob Dorem
and Simon Wheeler his Sureties entered into and acknowledged their bond in the
penalty of their hundred Dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted
them for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Robert Johnson
deceased in due form.

Ordered that Mills Muffee, Richard Muffee, Simon Muffee, James Wells and
William Edwards, or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this
County, do appraise in current money the value of any and personal estate of
Robert Johnson deceased and return the appraisement to the Court.

Ordered that Buffen Deth, John Dorem and James Harrison, or any two of them
do appraise State and Tolls the account of the administration of the estate of Jacob
Wells deceased and make a report thereof to the Court.

Peter Blow who this Court appointed an overseer of the poor in the upper District
and who resigned the office of Council-Blount who has disqualified himself by
accepting of an appointment from the United States of America and it is
ordered that the said Peter Blow be summoned to the next Court to qualify as
such according to Law.

Benjamin Blount one of the executors named in the last will and Testament of
Henry Blow deceased, this day in Court refusing to take upon himself the
burden of the executor thereof. On the motion of the said Benjamin Blount
who made oath and together with Samuel Blount and James Harris his Sureties
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Fifty thousand Dollars
conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of
administration on the said deceased estate with his will annexed in due form.

The last will and Testament of William Jones deceased was proved by the oaths of
James Rochelle, William B. Goodwin and John Deth the witnesses thereto and is ordered
to be recorded. The Executor therein named refuses to take upon himself the burden of
the executor thereof, on the motion of James B. Jones who made oath and together with
Samuel Blount, James Trogant, John Deth and Buffen Deth his Sureties entered into
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Fifty thousand Dollars conditioned as
the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on
said deceased estate with his will annexed in due form.
