 By bond of 4 parties their attorneys are the agent of the Court, this cause came on to be
 heard upon the bill and answer filed are the requirements of Counsel thereupon the Court with
 sequege order and decree that Jonathan Lute, Pittway Johnson, John Johnson, William Johnson
 of any three of them having advertised the same at some public place in the County of Southampton
 for one month to the highest bidder to the highest bidder on a credit of nine months the
 price to be subject to the misers laws to the highest bidder on a credit of nine months the
 land of which Miller Coggin was possessor and that they severally proceed into the Court house
 attesting one copy to Peter one copy to Miller one copy to Mary one copy to Lavinia
 one copy to Minniford and the remaining one copy to Mary M. Coggin that they take from the purchaser the bonds
 or other approved security, and assign the same to the Guardians of the infants, and that they
 make a report thereof to the Court in view to a final Decree

Arthur Brown is by the Court exempted on future from the payment of taxes and duties on his
 negroes Sam and Peter they being aged and infirm

On the petition of Benjamin Milson who made oath and together with Henry Graham his attorney
 entered into and acknowledge their bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned
 as the Law directs but if it is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate
 of Miller Coggin deceased in due form

Ordered that Jonathan Lute, Pittway Johnson, John Johnson and William Johnson or any
 three of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County do appraise in lowest money
 the slaves of any and personal estate of Miller Coggin deceased and return the appraisement to
 the Court

Richard Johnson is by the Court appointed guardian to John Powell orphan of John Powell who
 together with Henry Porter has been by the Court entered into and acknowledge their bond in the penalty of one
 thousand dollars with condition according to Law

On the petition of John Basham who made oath and together with Thomas Neese and John Key his
 securities entered into and acknowledge their bond in the penalty of one thousand and twenty
 dollars conditioned as the Law directs but if it is granted him for obtaining letters of
 administration on the estate of Rebecca Cogg deceased in due form

Ordered that William Barnes, William Williamson, George Jony and John Key or any three
 of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County do appraise in lowest money the
 slaves of any and personal estate of Rebecca Cogg deceased and return the appraisement to
 the Court
