as also for her sonnes in the same are finally that they make a report to this  
Court her order to a final Decree —

Eliza Sommerville only the sum expended in future from the payment of the taxes and  
deposits on her negro servant Barnabas the being agree and inform —

Order that John Barbare, Rowell before be cited to the persons appointed by a former order of this Court being just now before a magistrate of this County to appraise in current money the slaves if any are personal estate of Sally Rose deceased and return the appraisement to the Court —

This last will and Testament of James Ramsey esq; was proved by the attorney To my  
knowledge and by unanimous concurrence of the Subscribers, witnesses thereto and is  
deemed to be recorded And on the notice of said Ramsey one of the executors in the  
said will named who made with me together with Benjamin M. Johnson and  
David Newnam his Testimetic entered into and acknowledged their bond in the  
sum of One Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted  
him to have and to retain a probate thereof in the name of liberty as nominee for the  
other executors in the said will named to have in the probate when he shall think fit
