

Ordered that Francis Nisley, Thomas Nisley, Isaac Barnes and Lucy Waller or any three of them being first sworn before a Magistrate of this County do appraise in current money the value of any and personal Estate of Henry Taylor deceased and return the appraisement to the Court

An Indenture of bargain and Sale between James Jones, Jesse Sanford and ^{his associates} appointed by the County Court of Southampton of the one part and John Drake of the other part was acknowledged by the said bondholders and is ordered to be Recorded

Ordered that Joshua Bobbitt, Jonathan Luter and William Harris let the repairs of black oak bridge to the lowest undertaker, and that they require bond and approve Security from the undertaker or undertakers for the faithful completion of the undertaking and that they make a report to this Court

The Inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Doyal deceased being returned is ordered to be entered of Record

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court to make a division of the Lands amongst John Whitehead his wife and people this day make their report in the mode and figures following to wit. According to an order of the County Court of Southampton to us dated bearing date December Court 1814 We have gone on the different tracts of Land of John Whitehead deceased lying and being in the County of Southampton, appraised, attended with the County Surveyor as by the order we now require and have ascertained the quantity of each tract and have first marked the said tracts into equal parts and then subdivided the two largest parts of the said divisions into four equal parts by proper Measles and bounds in manner and form following to wit. 1st Lot No. 1 Beginning at a large White oak standing on the corner of William Williams Land. Thence S 15° E 226 pds to a red oak. Thence N 15° W 100 pds to a small branch that divides the house tract as called from the La road, thence along that branch the various bounds are thence to where it intersects Anthony Swamp, thence along Anthony Swamp, the various bounds thence to the White oak above and on first Station being Lot No. 1. Thence S 15° E 100 pds to the plantation and thence by John Whitehead's line to the East by the corner of the plantation 144 pds. Some values at 50 Shillings per Acre making 72 Acres being the proportionable part of the first by division after paying to John Williams 100 pds in the subdivision part of 1/2 of
