

division which was divided into 4 equal shares. the sum of 13 dollars, which sum was divided from 700 dollars leaves 707 dollars his part of the 4th division and all his part of the 5th division which 233.56 cents, to the 707.56 makes 934.56 his full proportion of the said lands in the division and Subdivision.

Thence beginning at a branch being the dividing line of the house tract and the plantation of Lott No 1 and 2 and running thence S 20 East 50 poles to a Cherry at the fork opposite the house thence S 20 East 100 poles to a turn of the road, thence S 60 N 60 poles thence S 40 N 100 poles to the stump called Authors Swamp, thence along that Swamp the various corners thence, the branch a dividing line of the Lott No 1 and 2 as aforesaid and then along that branch to the first Station, thence S 60 N 20 poles to the house Lott or new place, containing 100 Acres Valued at 750 into 75.00 Acres making 850 dollars which Lott was drawn by Daniel Howell being his proportionable part of the lands in the 1st division after paying to the children in right of their deceased Mother then Lott No 2 in the Subdivision of the same of 74 dollars and to Benjamin Whitehead Lott No 4 in the Subdivision of the same of 81 Dollars which sum was deducted from 850 Dollars leave the sum of 769 dollars and all the said Howell Lott No 3 - 233.56 of the Subdivision to the 700 Dollars which is his part of Subdivision Lott makes 934.56 his full proportion of the division and Subdivision.

Thence beginning at a new corner made 14 Poles from the tree pine left on Asphers Whiteheads Lott No 3 corner of Newbur Whitfields line being the dividing line between Whitfields and Asphers Whiteheads thence S 53 N 50 poles to a station on the line, thence S 20 West 76 poles to a dead Pine stump corner of Jacob Barnett thence N 70 N 100 poles to a new corner made in Jacob Barnett and Benjamin thence due north 95 poles to a pine house of Jacob Barnett, thence N 60 E 110 poles to first Station being Lott No 3 known by the upper Pine Woods Lott lying between Jacob Barnett Lott and Newbur Whitfields Lott in the James tract, which Lott was drawn by Asphers Whitehead containing 195 Acres Valued at 4 dollars per Acre making 780 dollars which is his proportionable part of the 4th division after paying to Benjamin Whitehead Lott No 4 in the Subdivision the sum of 50 and to Bathup Bonds Lott No 5 in Subdivision in right of his wife his right to the sum of 7 dollars which respective two sums deducted from 780 dollars leaves 700 dollars his part in the division of the said lands and all 704.56 into his proportionable part of the Subdivision of the 1/4 of the division to 700 dollars makes 934.56 his full proportion of the division and Subdivision of the lands of his deceased father.

Thence beginning at a dead pine stump a corner marked Barnett line, running thence S 60 West 104 poles to a pine station on the line, thence S 46 N 26 poles to small black gum at corner of New Draw, thence N 70 N 104 poles to a pine corner of Benjamin Whitfields, thence N 48 E 50 poles corner of Whitfields thence N 30 E 66 poles to the new corner of Benjamin Whitfields line at a small branch, thence S 79 N 20 poles thence S 61 E 40 poles thence N 80 E 20 poles to Jacob Barnett line being the same pole on first West through, thence N 66 E 25 poles to a dead pine stump in Jacob Barnett land, thence due north 140 Poles to a new corner made in Asphers Whiteheads line of Lott No 3 and thence along the dividing of Bonds and Whiteheads Lott No 5 to the first Station containing 175 acres being the said acre to be assigned to him by a decree of Southampton County Court, bearing date as first in this report mentioned
