

The persons appointed by a Decree of the County Court of Southampton to lay off and assign unto Rebecca Balf her share in the Lands whereof her deceased husband Edwin Balf died seized and possessed. This day make their report in the words and figures following (to wit) In obedience to an order and Decree made and signed following to wit. The County Court of Southampton bearing Date December Court 1894 to us directed in the undersigned accompanied by the deputy Surveyor of said County have allotted assigned and set apart to Rebecca Balf widow and relict of Edwin Balf deceased, one third part of the Lands in the said Decree or other mentioned in the following manner (to wit) Beginning at a pine the most northerly Eastern Corner of the late Adam Whipple better known tract of land running South 15 Degrees East 126 pds to a pine a corner of Benjamin Blunk's Land thence by the Side of the road leading from Top of the Jerusalem thence North 85 Degrees East 64 pds to a tree in said road thence North 55 Degrees East 54 pds to a Sweet Gum a corner of John Alexander Thomasson's Land on the Side of said road thence North 65 Degrees West 88 pds to a pine thence North 57 Degrees West 87 1/4 pds to a post back in said Thomasson's line thence South 57 West a Dividing line to the beginning estimated at fifty Seven Acres Given under our hands this Twenty eight day of January 1895. It is Decreed and ordered, that the division made as aforesaid be held firm and stable forever and that the cost be proportionably borne between the parties.

John Vick is appointed Surveyor of the road from Dick's Swamp to the High Bridge, in the town of Henry Blow deceased, and it is ordered that the mill belonging to the said who usually worked thereon, do attend and assist the said Surveyor in repairing the said road when required.

The persons appointed by a former Decree of this Court to make a division of the Lands whereof Joseph Scott died seized and possessed. This day make their report in the words and figures following (to wit)

Agreeable to an order of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing January Court 1895 We have gone on the Lands of Joseph Scott deceased where his formerly lived, attended with the County Surveyor, as by the order was more required and have run out and ascertained the quantity of the same and have laid off and assigned, to the widow of Joseph Scott deceased for life 110 Acres as her dower, by proper metes and bounds, to wit Beginning at a corner of Arab's Tract running thence N. 78 W. 68 pds to a post back in Eleanor's old line, thence due North 28 pds to the road thence along the road 70 pds to a pine a new corner made in the corner line thence N. 67. E. 190 pds to a perpendicular to a new corner made in the corner line and between Scott's old lot and the high land and Jonathan Scott's old lot thence the Corner post thence S. 21. E. 58 pds to a new corner made in Arab's Tract thence along his old bounds to the first Station containing 110 Acres being assigned to the widow as her dower for life.
