

The Persons appointed by a Decree of the County Court of Southampton to lay off and assign unto Rebecca Balf her share in the Lands whereof her deceased husband Lewis Balf died seized and possessed This day make their report in the words and figures following to wit

In obedience to an order and Decree made and entered in the County Court of Southampton bearing Date December Court 1874 to us directed in the undersigned accompanied by the deputy Surveyor of said County have allotted assigned and set apart to Rebecca Balf widow and relict of Lewis Balf deceased one third part of the Lands in the said Decree or the mutations in the following manner (to wit)

Beginning at a pine the most westerly Corner of the late Adam Clarke better known tract of Land running South 15 Degrees East 126 pds to a pine a corner of Benjamin Blunt's Land thence by the Side of the road leading from Longford to the Cathedral thence North 85 Degrees East 64 pds to a tree in the said road thence North 55 Degrees East 54 pds to a Sweet Gum a corner of John Alexander Thomasson's Land on the Side of said road thence North 65 Degrees West 88 pds to a pine thence North 57 Degrees West 87 1/4 pds to a post oak in said Thomasson's line thence South 57 West a Dividing line to the beginning estimated at fifty Seven Acres Given under our hands this Twenty eight day of January 1875. It is Decreed and ordered that the division made as aforesaid be held firm and stable forever and that the cost be proportionally borne between the parties

John Vick is appointed Surveyor of the road from Dick's Swamp to the bridge Bridge, in the town of Honey Blaw deceased, and It is ordered that the mill belonging to the said who usually worked thereon, do attend and assist the said Surveyor in repairing the said road when required

The persons appointed by a former Decree of this Court to make a division of the Lands whereof Joseph Scott died seized and possessed This day make their report in the words and figures following (to wit)

Applicable to an order of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing January Court 1875 We have gone on the Lands of Joseph Scott deceased in his formerly divided, attended with the County Surveyor, as by the order in which registered and have run out and ascertained the quantity of said lands and have laid off and assigned to the widow of Joseph Scott deceased for life 110 Acres as her dower, by proper metes and bounds, to wit Beginning at the corner of Arch Jones running thence N. 74 W. 68 pds to a post oak in Eleanor Cole's line, thence, due North 28 pds to the road thence along the road 70 pds to a pine a new corner made in the same line N. 28. 67. E. 190 pds to a persimmon tree a new corner made in the same line and let the said John Vick in the high Land and Jonathan Scott's Land in the Back part thence S. 21. E. 88 pds to a new corner made in Arch Jones's line thence along his out bounds to the first Station containing 110 Acres being assigned to the widow as her Dower for life
