Bradburn who were Town and Village Deacons and John Davis one of the people called Quakers who were served a grand Jury of this County and having received their charge were sent out of Court and after some time returned unto Court and presented The overseer of the road leading from the forks of the roads near Greenville to Jones Mill by this information of Athelred Garrison and John Darler弟兄 of our body - And the Grand Jury having nothing further to present were discharged

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court to let the repossessed Creekbridge this day made there report in the words and figures following to Wit, An Inventory to the overseer amounting to the sum of one hundred dollars and fifteen cents was received on the 1st of March, after giving one notice to let the affairs of Black Creek bridge. The Lender remitted to Wit, John Whetford for the sum of Ninety Nine dollars and Twenty four cents bond and security for the performance thereof due to be completed by the 1st May next. There being no hands this 20th day of March eighteen hundred and fifteen, ^{the day of payment before left, and the day of record}

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court to make a division of the land and slaves which Tol Edwards did say are his and his wife, this day made their report in the words and figures following to Wit, Agreeable to an view of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing date December Court 1814, We have gone over the lands of Tol Edwards which attested with the County Surveyor as by the view we now require, and have run out and apportioned the number of acres belonging to the Estate of the said deceased and find them to be 200th acres in the whole. We have also proceeded to divide the said lands in manner and form following to Wit, Beginning at the Swamp called the Little Swamp running thence S. 60. 36th pole to a new corner made in the corner line and an old Edwards lot No 2 there N. 60. 2. 64th pole to a pine lot a corner of Benjamin Whetford and now a corner of lot No 273 thence N. 19. W. 44th pole to the branch called the Piney Branch, thence along that branch to where it intersects the little Swamp, and thence along the Little Swamp to the first Station containing 60th acres being the lower right hand reward under and relief of Tol Edwards account, which we have granted to him for life only the decree was required. Thence beginning at a new corner made in William Bonn and Polly Edwards lots No 1 and 2 running thence S. 50. 3. 10 pole, thence due south 15 pole, thence S. 45. 2. 76 pole to the next thence N. 14. 2. 10 pole to a white oak a corner of Benjamin Whetford on the corner, thence N. 20. W. 45 pole thence N. 25. West 35 pole to a new corner made in lot No 1 and 2 thence S. 58. W. 45 pole along the corner line of lots No 1 and 2 to the first Station containing 30 acres value at \$ 50000th acre amounting to 150.00 being lot No 3 which lot was known by William Bonn in right of his deced mother Nancy Bonn formerly Nancy Edwards being his right wife in part of the said lands after receiving from lot No 3 the sum of 150 which sum added to 150 makes 300.00 cents William Bonn's proportionable part of the said lands in right of his deceased mother after taking one equal portion as the bequest of Mary Edwards or less in Tol Edwards' account at the death of himself or at a future day. There begins at a new corner made in William Bonn and Polly Edwards lots No 1 and 2 running thence N. 20. W. 45 pole to a lightwood lot a corner of Benjamin Whetford thence S. 60. 3. 14 pole another new corner made in lot No 1 and 2 in the other end corner thence S. 50. E. 45 pole to a new corner made in lot No 1 and 2 thence N. 58. W. 45 pole along the corner line of lots No 1 and 2 to the first Station containing 30 acres value
