Agreable to all Order of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing date
 January Court 1814 We have gone on the lands of Willie Henderwood deceased
 attended with the County Surveyor as by the order we were required and have now
 set out and apportioned the number of Acres within the out bounds of the said lands
 which we find to be 184 7/8 Acres and have done off and apportioned to Henderwood
 widow and relief of Willie Henderwood deceased 4 1/8 Acres of the said lands
 inclosing the dwelling house &c by proper lines and bounds above lower for life in
 manner and form following (No Net) Beginning at a Corner a new Corner made in
 the down line running thence 160 2/8 rods along the same — line to a post a new
 Corner made in the lower Steading below the House in the out bounds thence along
 the out bounds the various Courses thereof to the first Station containing 4 1/8 Acre being
 Octroy Henderwoods down right on said lands for life, after full partition agreeable
 to the quality as well as quantity thereof given under our hands this 20th day of

 and stable forever and that the Costs be proportionately borne between the parties —

 Giles Reed and Anslem Reed two of the witnesses thereunto and, on the motion of Nancy
 Reed the executrix thereon named who made oath thereto and together with Howell
 Nicholson and Daniel Henderwood her Testifiers entered into and acknowledged their
 bonds in the penalty of five Thousand dollars Conditions as the law directs Certificate
 is granted her full attesting a fiduciary in due form —

Ordered that John Nicholson, Howell Cooper, Thomas Estabrook and Kimberlittell or any three
 of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County do appear in Court
 Money the Rates if any are paid in Estate of Lucy J. Reed deceased are returned
 the appearance to the Court —

Richard Blunt is by the Court appointed Trustee for Martha C. Blunt widow of William Blunt
 deceased who together with William Phillips and Edmund Farmer trusties her Testifiers
 entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars with
 conditions according to law —
