 " the out bounds the various Courses thereof to the first Station containing 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ Acres being
 " Betsy Hendersons down right in said Lands for life, when full Bottom agreeable
 " to the quality as well as quantity thereof known unto our hands this 20th day of
 " February 1818. John Mitchell, Henry Porter, Thomas Porter Comperones —
 " Whereupon it is Decreed and ordered that the division made as aforesaid be held firm
 " and stable forever and that the Cots be proportionally borne between the parties —

Ordered that John Nicholson Howell Cooper, Thomas Best and Richard Little or any three
 of them being first sworn before a magistrate of this County as appraisers in Current
 Money the value of any and personal Estate of Lewis J. Reese deceased and return
 the appraisement to the Court —

Richard Blunt is by the Court appointed Guardian to Martha B. Blunt orphan of William Blunt
 deceased who together with William Phillips and Edmund Thomas James their Executors
 entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of five thousand dollars with
 Condition according to Law —
