On the petition of John Croshaw for leave to sell, he will leave two feet of the same as a sample, and if appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the same was not interested with any legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not, therefore His orders that a writ of Ad quod tenementum be issued under the Sheriff of this County, commanding him to summon and impanel twelve free persons to meet upon the lands in dispute for the raising of each mill dam, on the fifteenth day of April 1816. His orders be charged by the said Sheriff impartially, and to the best of their skill and judgment to view the said lands so prepared for the raising of the said mill dam having and require them to the extent of both parties and to examine above and below of the property of them, which may probably be confirmed, and say to what degree it will be proper to remove and what the nature of any such property, or the issue of the same or of any other property immediately belonging or on hand may be confirmed, to require whether and what degree of the said dam and raising navigation will be desirable, and whether in their opinion the health of the neighborhood will be improved by the regulation of the water, and that the report to be made and sealed by the said Surveyor, together with the writ, be returned by the said Sheriff to the next Court
