It is decreed and ordered that the decree rendered in this Cause at the last Court be so
 amended that the Names in the bill mentioned be directed in kind.

The Indenture of bargain and sale between Henry Jones and Elizabeth his wife of the one
 part and James Jones of the other part was acknowledged by the said Henry Jones and as
 to him is ordered to be admitted of Records.

The Sheriff having made return, that the day which was Summons on a writ of ad quod
 damnum about the Cricklow's mill failed to attend therefore it is ordered that an alias
 writ of ad quod damnum be issued directed to the Sheriff of this County commanding him
 to Summons and inquire twelve fit persons to meet upon the lands so proposed for the raising
 of the said Cricklow's mill dam two feet across the barometer Swamp on the second Friday in
 May next who shall be charged by the said Sheriff impartially and to the best of their Skill
 and Judgment to view the said lands so proposed for the raising of the said mill dam
 having due regard therein to the interest of both parties and to appraise the same according
 to its true value, to examine the lands above and below of the property of others, which may
 probably be overflowed, and say to what damage it will be of the several proprietors and
 whether the masonry House of any such proprietors or the offices, cartways or gardens
 therunto immediately belonging, or orchards will be overflowed to enquire whether and in
 what degree fish or passage and ordinary navigation will be obstructed and whether in
 their opinion the health of the neighbours will be annoyed by the stagnation of the waters
 and that the request so to be made and sealed by the said Juries, together with this
 writ be returned by the said Sheriff to the next Court.

The lost will and Testament of Samuel Francis deceased was proved by the oaths of John
 Spencer and Thomas Jones the witnesses thereto and is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that John Fort and William Kitchen in addition to the persons appointed by a former
 order of this Court or any three of them do examine elate and settle an account of French Vicks
 payable within this County and make report to the Court.
